PAVING NOTICE

TO: Residents along the Reconstruction Project

City of Cokato

DATE: May 11, 2021

Street sweeping is planned to occur starting on Monday, May 17th.

The bituminous paving is planned to occur along Mooers Ave, 4^{th} St SE, 6^{th} St SE on Tuesday, May 18^{th} .

The bituminous paving is planned to occur along 4^{th} St SW and Millard Ave on Wednesday, May 19^{th} .

Please move your vehicle out of your driveway and park on an adjacent street outside of the construction zone by 7:00 a.m. so construction can progress smoothly. If you do not need to use your vehicle during the day, you may park it in your driveway.

If construction is delayed due to inclement weather, assume it will proceed the following day. Please do not park any vehicles or trailers on the street until the paving is complete. Construction crews will need to have the street clear in order to complete the work.

It is very common on these types of projects that area residents (especially children) become quite curious about the work the Contractor is performing. We ask that you please be respectful of and stay well clear of construction zones. Many hazards and dangers exist from heavy machinery, loose material, confined spaces, hot asphalt, etc. and often times are not recognizable by the general public. The Contractor has responsibility to ensure safety on the project and within the construction area. Any direction from the Contractor regarding safety must be heeded; likewise if you observe an unsafe condition please report it to the Construction Representative immediately.

Prior to paving, the contractor will spread a bituminous tack coat on the road. This is a sticky material that can stick to tires and shoes. Avoid it if possible.
